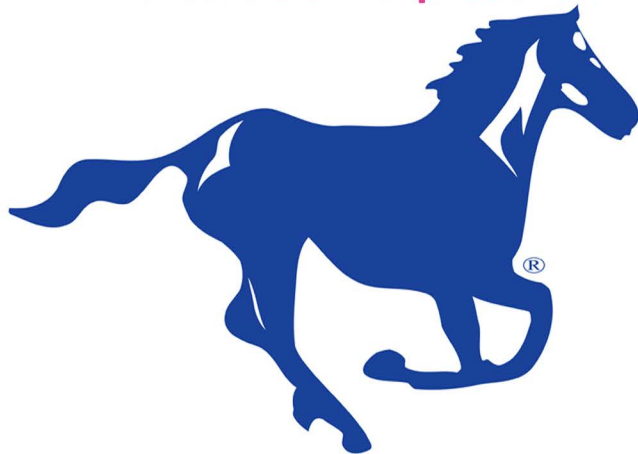

2. Wash your hands with soap and water or use hand wipes and waterless hand hygiene solution immediately after handling horses.
3. Do not share equipment, including food and water containers, between horses. Avoid use of communal water troughs.
4. Do not knowingly take sick horses to an event.
5. If a horse is unwell at an event, notify an event official.
6. Stop all non-essential contact with the sick horse and blood or body fluids from the horse until a veterinarian has excluded Hendra virus infection as the cause of illness.
7. Do not allow children to have close contact with a sick horse, at least until infection has been ruled out by a veterinarian.
8. Promptly isolate sick horses and seek veterinary advice. Also isolate any equipment in contact with the sick horse.

North Queensland Western Performance Horse Club Inc. CONDITIONS OF ENTRY - 2021

1. The age of the horse shall be calculated from August 1st in any year.
2. Halter horses must be registered with their respective breed and a copy of the horse's registration must be sent in with nominations.
3. Amateur owners must have a current owner's card from their respective association.
4. All competitors must be ready for the stated starting times. Classes will not be held up for competitors who are not at the ring on time.
5. One horse one rider applies for NQWPHC high points. At least three (3) classes must be entered in your division to be eligible for that high point award.
6. Youth riders must have written consent from parent or guardian.
7. NQWPHC INC. Events are conducted under a COVID safe plan.
8. Disputes to be in writing accompanied by \$50, which will be refunded if the dispute is upheld.
9. Competitors ride at their own risk. The NQWPHC Inc. will not accept responsibility for accident, loss or injury to competitors, horses or spectators.
10. Competing non-members need to fill out a waiver form to compete and a \$15 per day fee applies if they are not a member of the NQWPHC.
11. **NQWPHC Novice Senior Horse** is a transitional division designed for horses 6 years and over that are not yet ready to be shown in Senior Horse Classes one handed in a shank bit, but are working towards it.
Club rules are:

11.1. HSAA dress code and tack rules apply. Horses can be shown two handed in a snaffle or one handed in a shank bit (horses will not be disqualified for minimal assistance given two handed in a shank; but credit will be given to those without assistance).

11.2. Horses nominated in this division are not able to show in any other open class of the same name (i.e. if showing in Novice Senior Horse Trail they cannot nominate in SH, AO or Youth Trail). They may however show in Senior Horse Classes of a different name (i.e. show in Senior Horse Western Pleasure one handed in a shank if they are ready, but may show back in Novice Senior Horse Trail if that is the class the horse needs Assistance in). There is no time limit in this category which allows horses to progress to Senior Horse Classes as their horses are ready. This class is a NQWPHC class only and points will not be recognised with respective breed societies, e.g. PHAA/AQHA/AAA.

12. **NQWPHC Beginner Youth and Beginner Adult** divisions provide a great starting opportunity for riders making their first steps into the western performance show arena without having to purchase the full legal western tack and attire.

Club rules are:

12.1. Riders may show in English, stock or western saddle. No training devices such as martingales, dropped nosebands, tie downs, dressage whips / riding crops etc. are allowed. Long sleeves shirt, jeans/jodhpurs, boots, and hat or helmet are mandatory. Beginner youth must wear an Australian Standard protective helmet.

12.2. To be eligible a rider has not had 3 wins in a particular class two handed and 2 wins in a particular class one handed in a shank bit or one win in open company in that class. This rule applies to beginner riders from other local clubs.

This class is a NQWPHC class only and points will not be recognised with respective breed societies, e.g. PHAA/AQHA/AAA.

13. Nominations are due on or before the Monday before the show. Nominations will be accepted by email. Nominations are to be paid in full at time of nomination via prior bank deposit or direct debit.

14. Ribbons to 6th will be awarded.

15. **Any person riding on the grounds regardless of whether they are competing or not must pay a day fee and sign a waiver / temporary membership form.**

16. Youth walk jog & lead line – it is mandatory to wear Australian Standard protective helmets.

17. All beginner youth classes - it is mandatory to wear Australian Standard protective helmets.

18. All beginner adult classes - NQWPHC highly recommend competitors wear Australian Standard Protective helmets.

19. Competitor's/participants at any event run by NQWPHC have a responsibility to ensure the welfare of their horses and at all times to treat their horses humanely and with dignity, respect and compassion. Competitors/participants are to conduct themselves in a professional manner and act with integrity in all dealings with NQWPHC and other competitors. To uphold the rules and regulations of the NQWPHC, AQHA, HSAA & PHAA at all times.

Competitors/participants are to demonstrate good sportsmanship at all times, showing respect for your fellow competitors and officials, following the rules and to treat people the way you yourself wish to be treated.

20. No alcohol is allowed in, or can be consumed in the marshaling areas, working arenas or show pen/contest areas. All youth competing or taking part in an NQWPHC event, must have written permission from their parent/guardian to be at that event as a contestant or participant and in the case of a contest, the parent/guardian must also sign the entry form. All youth competing or taking part in a NQWPHC event, must be in the care of a responsible adult who is in attendance for the duration of that event, whilst the youth is in attendance at that event.

21. **Youth lead line** – in accordance with AQHA rule 63.15 this class is for riders three (3) years to six (6) years of age (as at 1st August), no 2 or 3 year old horses can be used in this class; it is mandatory for this class that an approved safety helmet is worn; no rider entering this class can enter any other ridden class on the program; and this is a non point scoring class.

22. **Youth Walk Jog/Trot** – in accordance with AQHA rule 63.16 this class is for youth five (5) years to ten (10) years (as of 1st August), no 2 or 3 year old horses can be used in this class; it is mandatory for this class that an approved safety helmet is worn; no rider entering this class can enter any other ridden class on the program; and this is a non point scoring class.

23. **The show is run under HSAA** rules in conjunction with NQWPHC and AQHA rules. Please be sure to read conditions of entry and acquaint yourself with the appropriate class rules from the HSAA/PHAA and AQHA rule books.

24. **Walk jog** is open to any rider but if competing in walk jog riders are not allowed to compete in any other class in that division (e.g. if a rider competes in walk jog western pleasure they are not able to enter any other classes in western pleasure). Tack and attire rules as per clause 12.1 Beginner adult/youth. This class is a NQWPHC class only and points will not be recognised with respective breed societies, e.g. PHAA/AQHA/AAA.

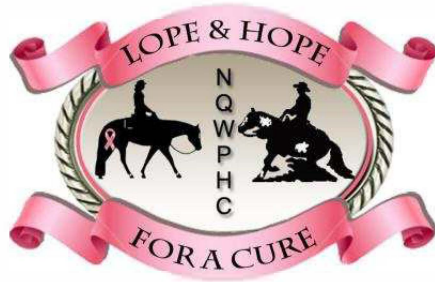
25. Memorial Trail Class is open to all riders competing in any division. Tack and attire rules apply as per rider's division (ie senior horse, novice adult etc)..

26. Patterns will be released upon receipt of nominations and will be emailed directly.

27. Competitors must comply with the Tully Performance Horse Centre grounds management plan including, amongst other things: all manure must be placed in designated disposal area; **no dogs allowed** on the grounds; and no horses in the club house area.

28. **EWD** (Equestrians with disabilities) competitors **MUST** send a copy of their breed associations endorsement permit with their nominations to be eligible to compete - AQHA rule number 96.

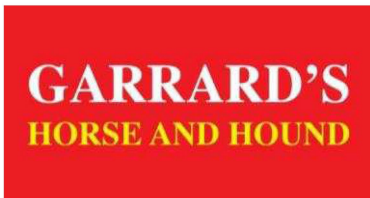
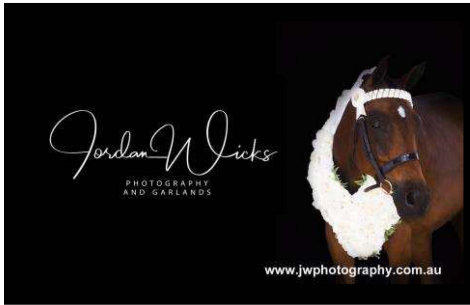
